
Virtual Card Payments for Vendors: A Quick Benefits Guide

What is a Virtual Card?

A virtual card is a secure, fast way to receive payment. Virtual Cards are just like physical credit cards, just without the physical piece of plastic, which makes them more convenient and secure. **Virtual cards have everything you need to process a card payment:**



If you can process a physical card, you can process a virtual card.

How Do I Use a Virtual Card?

- We send you a secure, encrypted, email with your virtual card and payment information. This email will include important information like:
 - Card Account Information
 Account Number, Expiration Date, and CVV
 - Payment information
 Payer Name, Payment Amount, Payment Date
 - Remittance information
 Invoice Number, Invoice Date, etc
- Use the Card Account information and Payment information to key enter the payment into your credit card processing software. If you use a physical terminal for this, you'll use it just like you would for a physical card.
- You will receive funds from your virtual card payments from your credit card processer.

There are no additional fees from Bottomline to process card payments; you will be charged your processer's typical fees.
